The Niagara Falls Community Health Centre (NFCHC) is a collaborative, inter-professional health care team that strives to service our local community with a specialized focus on individuals that have barriers to care. We are seeking applications for an experienced and highly motivated Registered Nurse who is committed to providing care to marginalized populations. The NFCHC values teamwork and collaboration where the RN will collaborate with other members of the team to maximize team-based care.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Practice to full scope and deliver primary care as per NFCHC's medical directives. This includes (but not limited to): allergy injections, immunizations, influenza immunizations, well-women and well-baby assessments, administer bloodwork, assessment and treatment of STIs and UTIs, wart removal and point of care testing.
- Responsible for health education while remaining informed of clinical guidelines and recommendations.
- Lead phone triage.
- Administer on-site bloodwork.
- Provide point of care in other community settings as identified by the Senior Leadership Team.
- Responsible to maintain high quality standards and timely documentation in the Electronic Medical Records (EMR).
- Work in a manner that demonstrates commitment to NFCHC's mission, vision, and values.

Requirements:

- Current degree in Nursing from an accredited institution.
- Registered and in good standing with the RNAO.
- Minimum or the equivalent of three years' experience as an RN in a community setting, primary care office experience is considered an asset.
- Basic understanding and knowledge of Clinical Connect.

Additional Requirements

- Ability to work other hours as requested by Senior Leadership Team.
- Maintain and provide proof of liability insurance.
- Possession of a valid Ontario Drivers' License, access to a reliable vehicle and a Police Reference Check are required.
- As a healthcare facility, we require proof of routine immunizations and COVID-19 vaccines.
