We are seeking applications for an experienced and highly motivated Occupational Therapist who is committed to providing care to marginalized populations. The NFCHC values teamwork and collaboration where the OT will collaborate with other members of the team to maximize team-based care.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Supporting the work of primary care patients by completing ODSP applications, ADL assessments, mobility and ambulation assessment and cognitive assessments (e.g. Moca/ MMSE)
- Doing occasional home visits to access accessibility and falls prevention issues
- Providing 1:1 chronic pain education and supporting a chronic pain group
- Supporting our respiratory education program and exercise (CRE Designation an asset)
- Facilitating Education sessions both virtually and in-person on a variety of topics including sleep hygiene
- Regular Consulting with clinical team to monitor needs of clients
- Provide point of care in other community settings as identified by the Senior Leadership Team.
- Responsible to maintain high quality standards and timely documentation in the Electronic Medical Records (EMR).
- Work in a manner that demonstrates commitment to NFCHC's mission, vision, and values.

Requirements:

- Current Master's degree in Occupational Therapy from an accredited institution.
- Registered and in good standing with the College of Occupational Therapists.
- Minimum or the equivalent of three years' experience as an OT in a healthcare setting
- Maintain and provide proof of liability insurance.
- Possession of a valid Ontario Drivers' License, access to a reliable vehicle and a Police Reference Check are required.
- As a healthcare facility, we require proof of routine immunizations and COVID-19 vaccines.
